As we collect all the wonderful professional development certificates, we are great at finding a secure location for all of them. Might I suggest that you make a folder in your Google Drive where you can



upload all of those certificates? When it's time to renew, simply share the folder with the recertification specialist, currently, Amy Lamb.

Here is how I will do it:

Step 1: Make a folder in Google Drive. Label it "Recertification Certificates" (for example)

Step 2a: If I am given a paper certificate, scan it (or take a picture of it), and upload it to the folder I labeled.

Step 2b: If I am emailed a certificate then I download it to my desktop to upload to my folder.

Step 3: During your recertification year, share the folder to the specialist to verify.
