
## NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

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**June 24, 2020- Lottsburg, Virginia** – The Northumberland County Public Schools' School Board met at the Northumberland County School Board Office beginning at noon for a Special Called Meeting and 2020-2021 Budget Work Session. The public had access through audio conferencing as a result of the Governor's Executive Orders and COVID-19 guidelines.

The School Board approved the 2020-2021 Budget in the amount of \$18,612,949, an increase of \$336,126. Included in the Budget was a 2% raise for all current personnel and an additional full time school counselor position. The Finance Department is processing the contracts to be mailed to employees on Friday, June 26, 2020.
