Superintendent's Report

Dr. Holly Wargo reported school division updates:

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- → NCPS currently is recruiting for the following open positions: middle school counselor, high school counselor, and high school English teacher.
- → The Northumberland County Litter Committee, with the assistance of Beta Clubs and JROTC, hosted a Tire Amnesty Event on April 29, 2023. The event was a tremendous success.
- → NCPS continues to strengthen inclusive practices and has established a taskforce and is working on professional development opportunities for the upcoming school year, to include Convocation.
- → Standards of Learning testing is in progress throughout the month of May.
- → NCPS is preparing for online enrollment and registration for the 2023-2024 school year.
- → All computers will need to be returned to the technology staff at the end of this school year for updating and maintenance. Notification has been posted via website, social medias, letter, and phone calls home.
- → Federal and ESSER reimbursements continue to be filed for approval.
- → One 53 passenger school bus for students with disabilities has been ordered with an expected delivery date of July 2023. Thank you to the Board of Supervisors for approving this order.
- → NCPS School Nutrition team received commendations during a federal review: "The cafeteria staff makes great effort to cook meals from scratch. We commend you for these efforts and encourage you to continue serving more scratch-made foods . . ."
- → The academic and athletic new construction project is progressing: We have drywall hung and finished at 85%; we are awaiting electrical panels which are scheduled for next week; we will start install as soon as they arrive; doors and hardware have arrived will be installed next two weeks; the gutter and exterior of building is complete; sitework on exterior should start in next two weeks; we still are awaiting HVAC arrival of the units to work on interior painting and flooring; delivery of HVAC has been moved delivery back to June.
